“Liberty Bay Credit Union is proud to partner with the Cooperative Credit Union Association to bring the gift of reading to homeless children in Massachusetts. Children from low-income families are at greater risk for entering school without basic reading skills. We would like to help children be prepared for school by making sure accessibility to books is not an issue,” said Charlette Robichaud of Community Matters.

Liberty Bay Credit Union will be collecting new and gently used children’s books during business hours throughout April at the branch locations in Braintree, Hingham, Scituate and Woburn. The books will be distributed to children mid-May.
